ILLINOIS DIRECTOR CREDENTIAL

The Gateways Illinois Director Credential includes college coursework and credential-approved training in ECE or School-Age Administration.

Below are examples that meet Administrative content for the Illinois Director Credential.

Administrative content can be met by taking college level coursework.

Below are examples of college course titles that fully meet administrative content areas:

- Financial and Legal Aspects of Child Care Management
- Leadership, Advocacy and Supervision of Early Childhood Programs
- Administration and Supervision of Programs for the Young Child

General business or administrative coursework may receive partial credit. Below are examples of course titles that may earn partial credit in the Gateways Administrative Content Areas:

- Personnel Management
- Principles of Management
- Foundations of Educational Leadership

Illinois Child Care Licensing representatives determine if you are Teacher, Assistant Teacher, or Director Qualified.

PER ILLINOIS CHILD CARE LICENSING STANDARDS FOR DAY CARE CENTERS: All new child care directors hired on or after July 1, 2017 shall have a minimum of an associate degree in child development or early childhood education, or the equivalent (defined as 64 semester hours in any discipline with a minimum of 21 semester hours of college credit in child development, early childhood education or early childhood special education) and either a Gateways to Opportunity Level I Illinois Director Credential (see 89 Ill. Adm. Code 50.720(b)) or 3 semester hours of college credit or **3 points of credential approved training in administration, leadership or management.**

Gateways to Opportunity®/INCCRRRA staff does not make staffing qualification decisions.

Important Reminder! The Illinois Director Credential (IDC) has three levels. The IDC Level I requires an Associate's degree or higher, the IDC Level II requires a Bachelor's degree or higher, and the IDC Level III requires a Graduate degree. **The IDC Level II and IDC Level III go above and beyond the IDC Level I requirements.**

Aim4Excellence™ Director Credential at National Louis University

Aim4Excellence™ includes nine self-paced modules that can be taken for college credit or training clock hours.

Completion of any three modules meets three points in the Gateways Administrative content areas.

ChildCare Education Institute – Director’s Certificate

The Director’s Certificate, by ChildCare Education Institute (CCEI) provides information for early childhood professionals seeking to further their skills and knowledge in the management of a child care center. Completion of the CCEI Director’s Certificate meets three points in the Gateways Administrative content areas.
