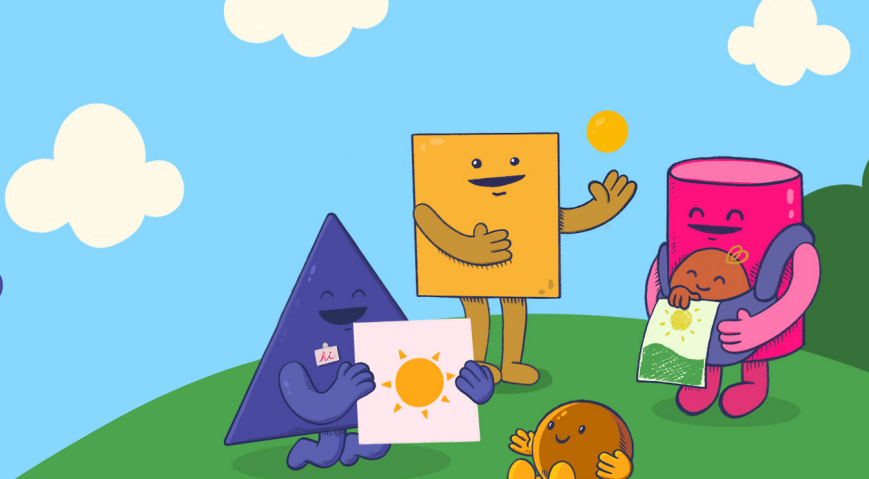


# Early Childhood Education and Care (ECEC) Enrollment Community Outreach Grant RFP

The goal of these grants is to promote and connect families to Early Childhood Education and Care (ECEC) programs and boost enrollment throughout local communities in the state of Illinois for children ages birth to 12. ECEC programs for this RFP include: the Child Care Assistance Program, Head Start/ Early Head Start, Early Intervention, Home Visiting, Preschool for All /Prevention Initiative, and Child Care. The state will also be engaged in a large overarching Enrollment Campaign, under the leadership of the Governor’s Office of Early Childhood Development, with media purchases at the same time as this RFP. Local agencies/organizations will use the branding and marketing developed for the state campaign and tailor it to their local communities and events.

Though we received numerous RFPs, not all regions were covered; therefore, we will be re-issuing the initial RFP for the regions listed below.
