 - o Discussed tips & tricks when reviewing the applications.
 - o Discussed the Competency Alignment Table (CAT):
 - The courses listed in the primarily assessed column should be listed on the program layout.
 - When utilizing multiple courses in the primarily assessed column, the program needs to indicate "or". Will be removing "and" from the application.
 - Assessment tools need to descriptive; (e.g. paper → philosophy paper, student teaching → student teaching evaluation form).
- Discussed the Program Layout (PL):
 - For each level, the course(s) listed in the primarily assessed column should be listed on the program layout for that level.
 - Observation/experience hours need to be listed for the level or a note that the student will need to provide Gateways with the difference in field experience hours.
- A resource checklist was provided to the group on Dropbox by the co-chairs to help them along reviewing the applications.
- Discussed the voting process for recommendations: approved, provisionally approved, and/or need INCCRRA to attain more information regarding the program.
