**Welcome**

- Attendees were welcomed to the meeting and meeting minutes from September 21, 2021, were approved.

**New Applications for Competency Entitlement**

- University of Illinois -Urbana/Champaign FSC 2-5
  - Concern over assessments – too general, vague, and random. Committee asked for better assignment descriptions and detail on assessments.
  - Committee asked for the words “and/or” be added between several lists of courses.
  - Discussion about how assignment descriptions in syllabi should match what is listed in the final assessment on the CAT.
  - Not approved at this time, sent back for changes.
- Erikson Institute IECMH Program FSC 2- 5
  - Committee felt that they met the required qualifications for FSC Levels 2- 5.
  - Stacy Thompson called for a motion to approve
  - Kathy Nikolai motioned to accept
  - Stacie Kirk seconded.
  - Approved by committee.
- Heartland Community College FSC 2-3
  - Julie Cotter recused herself from review
  - Committee requested that the words, “and/or” be added between lists of courses.
  - Committee requested more detail on assessments
  - Committee requested the general education courses be taken off of the program layout
  - Concern over student completer names being shared with Gateways. Committee requested wording to be included stating that completer numbers will be shared with gateways, not names of students.
  - Stacy Thompson called for a motion to approve with provisions
  - Pat Chamberlain moved to accept
  - Kathy Nikolai seconded
  - Julie Cotter abstained.
  - Approved by committee with provisions
- Elgin Community College
  - ECE Track FSC 2
    - Committee felt that they met the qualifications for FSC level 2
    - Stacy Thompson called for a motion to approve
    - Stacie Kirk moved to accept the motion

- Pat Chamberlain seconded.
- Approved by committee
- Human services – Generalist Track FSC 2-4
  - Committee recommended that the assessments be more specific; the discussions and journals need more clarification.
  - Courses HUS201 and HSG 201 need clarification – one is a typo
  - Committee recommends that the HGD Gateways Tool Box assessment be clarified to show that FSC is being used.
  - Level 4 hours are listed as 10, is this a typo? Should be 100. Committee recommends this be clarified.
  - Stacy Thompson called for a motion to approve with the above provisions
  - Kathy Nikolai moved to accept the motion
  - Julie Cotter seconded.
  - Move to amend vote on the ECE track FSC 2
  - Amended vote to approve ECE Track FSC 2 to provisional with the same conditions as the Human Services Track FSC 2-4.
- Illinois Central College ECE 2-4
  - Concern over too many courses listed for Level 4. Committee recommends adding the terms “and/or” for the courses listed.
  - Concern over assessments – too vague, unclear. Committee recommends clarification and detail on assessments.
  - Concern over the wording being changed by the applicant on competencies. Recommends the wording be kept to original form on application.
  - Concerns over hours listed/wording used to list hours on the program layout. Committee recommends the hours be clarified on all 3 levels.
  - Committee did not approve application at this time.
