  - o Cross-cultural studies for teaching limited-English-proficient students
  - o Methods and materials for teaching English as a Second Language (ESL)
  - o Elective (an additional bilingual or ESL course)
- 100 clock hours (or 3 months teaching experience) in a bilingual setting
- · Appropriate Target Language Proficiency or English Language Proficiency test (if applicable)
