- 300 direct route pilot applications have been received.
- 28 entitled route pilot applications have been received.
- 52 post-pilot direct route applications have been received.
- 130 Family Child Care Credentials have been awarded.

Family Child Care Goals – Ad-hoc Opportunity

- Cathy Main explained the charge of this ad-hoc.
 - Illinois has a team working with the report from the Institute of Medicine to make recommendations for incrementally increasing competency based qualification requirements across all sectors where young children are served.
 - There have been recommendations made for teachers and teacher assistants in center based care and recommendations are also desired for family child care.
 - The charge of this ad-hoc is to *draft* a recommendation for family child care provider and assistant provider education qualifications.
 - This *draft* will serve as a *starting point* for the Saturday, October 29, 2016 (faceto-face) conversation with the Family Child Care Credential Committee.
 - The ad-hoc will meet via telenet on Thursday, October 6, 2016 and Thursday, October 13, 2016 from 1:00 – 2:00 PM.
