Overview of Family Child Care Credentials Awarded

- Inclusive of pilot applicants, 320 FCC Credentials have been awarded.
 - 189 – Level 2
 - 54 – Level 3
 - 58 – Level 4
 - 19 – Level 5

Renewal Recommendation Update (Attachment A)

- The following recommendation for the renewal of the Family Child Care Credential was presented to the Qualifications and Credentials (QC) Committee on February 6, 2018. The recommendation was not approved.
 - Family Child Care Credential Levels 3 – 5:
 - Renewal of the Gateways to Opportunity specialization Family Child Care (FCC) Credential requires renewal of the foundational ECE or SAYD Credential, which requires 45 clock hours of training (or 3 semester hours of coursework) in ECE and/or School-Age. To renew the FCC Credential, it is recommended that 15 of those 45 clock hours be specific to family child care.
 - A combination of both college coursework and training hours may be utilized and completed within the last five years.
 - Current Registry Membership
 - Family Child Care Credential Level 2:
 - In alignment to the renewal of the FCC Credential Levels 3 – 5, the FCC Credential Level 2 requires 45 clock hours of training (or 3 semester hours of coursework) in ECE and/or School-Age with 15 of those 45 clock hours specific to family child care.
 - A combination of both college coursework and training hours may be utilized and completed within the last five years.
