Pilot Updates

- 260 direct route applications received
 - o 55 total direct route credentials awarded
 - 2 Level 5
 - 1 was a Level Advance from Level 4.
 - 14 Level 4
 - 13 Level 3
 - 26 Level 2
- 22 entitled route applications received
 - o 5 total entitled route credentials awarded
 - 0 Level 5
 - 2 Level 4
 - 1 Level 3
 - 2 Level 2
- Pilot survey was emailed to applicants and faculty on February 23, 2016.
 - Pilot survey responses were recorded on March 8, 2016.
- Final Pilot report is currently being drafted.
- Target dates for final recommendations are as follows:
 - o QC April 19, 2016
 - Steering May 18 and 19, 2016
 - o PDAC June 17, 2016
- Family Child Care Credential Entitled Route Faculty met at INCCRRA on Tuesday, March 8, 2016 to review surveys and discuss all aspects of the pilot.

 - Number 40 approved for FCC Credential Level 2
 - Number 81 approved for FCC Credential Level 2
 - Number 83 approved for FCC Credential Level 3
 - Number 131 approved for FCC Credential Level 4
 - Number 228 approved for FCC Credential Level 3
 - Check for more practicum information. If applicant has Advocacy or Technology may qualify for Level 4.
 - Follow up with applicant and committee 3/11/16 did not show
 Advocacy or Technology. Stay at Level 3.
 - Number 229 approved for FCC Credential Level 4
 - Number 235 approved for FCC Credential Level 2

 - Practicums in FCEM will be reviewed based on the applicant's description and/or course description/syllabi to determine point spread.
