#### Review and Approval of September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022, meeting minutes

#### PDAC Strategic Plan – QC Goal 4, Objective 4 – Stephanie Hellmer & Joni Scritchlow

- *Deepen knowledge of credentialed and non-credentialed workforce through data collection focused on current and emerging demographics and ongoing inequities.*
- Credential website survey – (Attachment A)
  - Beginning in August, a short Gateways Credential survey was added to the Gateways website.
  - The purpose of the survey was to gain personal experience feedback regarding the current Gateways Credential application process. This survey was not intended for those who gained a Credential in the past.
    - There have been many changes to streamline the Credential process, including individualized eligibility emails sent with specific courses and/or Credential-approved trainings to gain a Credential, using already verified work experience/practical hours, etc.
  - More than 180 individuals completed the survey.
    - Response rate was one – two percent of the 12,000 applications received in 2022.
  - Responses and processes leaned more positive than negative – 58% positive and 42% negative.
    - We are pleased to have more than 50% with a positive Credential experience.
  - The comments were not all related to Credentials.
    - Anecdotally, the comments were voicing frustration, likely because the applicant is not yet eligible.
  - Potential future survey question: Ask for the level of Credential obtained or if the application is still pending.
  - Could this be posted on the website for individuals to view the survey results?

### Gateways Credential Career Lattice – Bela Moté

- Gateways Career Lattice options (Attachment B) and PDAC QC recommendation (Attachment C).
- A five-finger vote resulted in 100% voting five fingers to add the Gateways ESL & Bilingual Credential to the Gateways Credential Career Lattice using Option 2.

### ExceleRate Relationship Based Professional Development (RBPDP) Pilot – Teri

- During the last QC meeting, the Workforce Development and Pathways (WDP) recommendation was shared specific to the definition of Job Embedded Professional Development (JEPD). To summarize, JEPD is the continuum of learning that is grounded in day-to-day practice.
- Working with INCCRRA, the McCormick Center backward mapped the Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) training to the Illinois Director Credential (IDC) competencies. Recognizing the model of JEPD, five IDC competencies were identified and aligned to the CQI training:
  - IDC PPS – Personal and Professional Self-Awareness
    1. PPS1 Identify strategies to support personal and professional development.
    2. PPS3 Implement reflective and intentional administrative practices.
    3. PPS4 Develop, implement, and assess plans that support personal and professional development as well as the status of the profession.
  - IDC LA – Leadership and Advocacy
    4. LA1 Evaluate organizational climate and program and classroom quality, using valid and reliable tools, and implement improvement plans based on data gathered.
    5. LA2 Collaboratively evaluate program effectiveness and utilize data to inform continuous quality improvement efforts.
- The CQI training includes some online webinars, a Community of Practice (CoP), coaching to the CQI content, and demonstrates competencies can be met outside of a course and maintain rigorous content without lessening the standards.
  - Could the CQI training also meet competencies under the Technical Assistance (TA) Credential?
    - This CQI training was purposefully designed to meet IDC competencies. Programs/Centers need multiple leaders, for example, Pedagogical, Family Specialists, Financial Management, Professional Development Coordinators, etc.
  - We are still unsure on how to show competencies in the Gateways Registry. More guidance is needed.

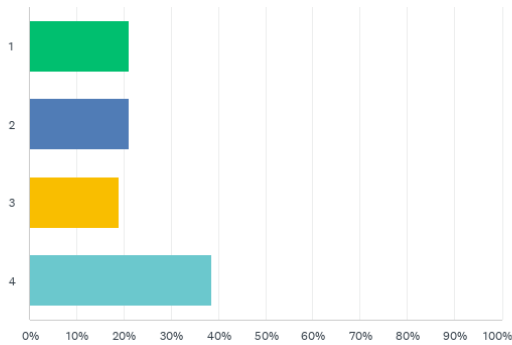

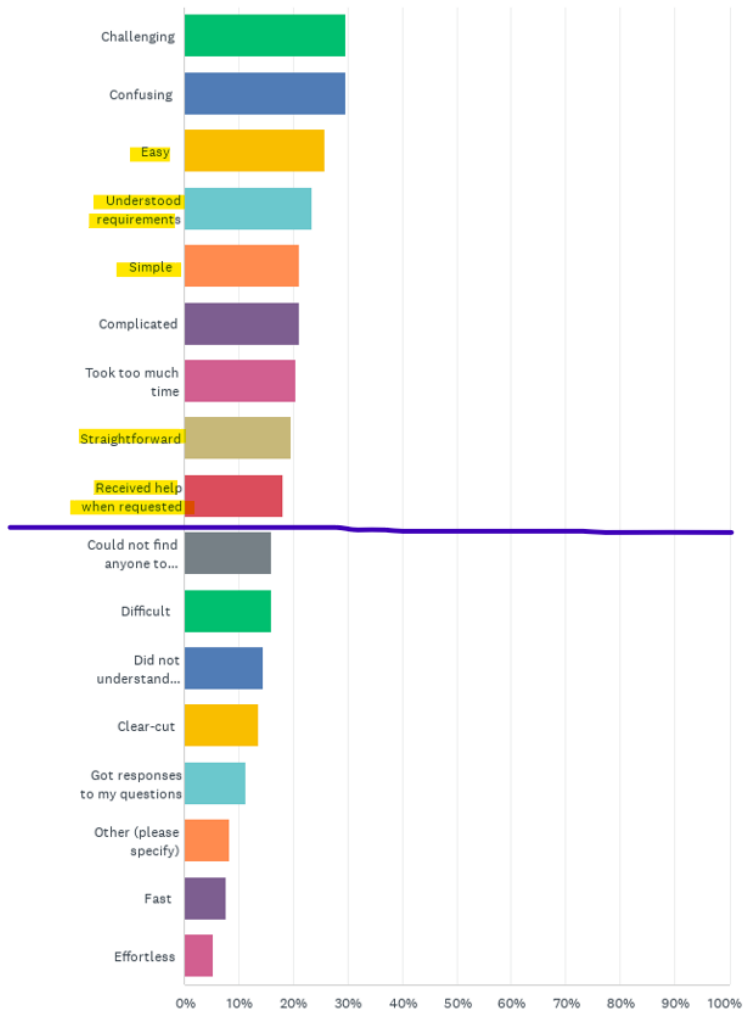
Q1 On a scale of 1 to 4, please rate your experience in applying for a Gateways Credential (with 4 being an easy process and 1 being a difficult process)

**Comments that we already do: Any clarity needed?**

Reminder emails 1 month before expiration.	Email blasts January, July, and October.
Send out emails of all updates.	Email blasts quarterly to pending applicants.
When offering free credentials, offer free renewals as well.	They are free.
Program directors access their staff's information, what is needed, credential advisor letter, would it be possible to email to both employer and applicant (have a signed permission).	Director's Portal shows pending application reasons.
More "payoff" for having credentials (increasing the levels for Great START for example). It is hard to sell it to staff if some don't see the personal advantage.	Credentials are in Great START.

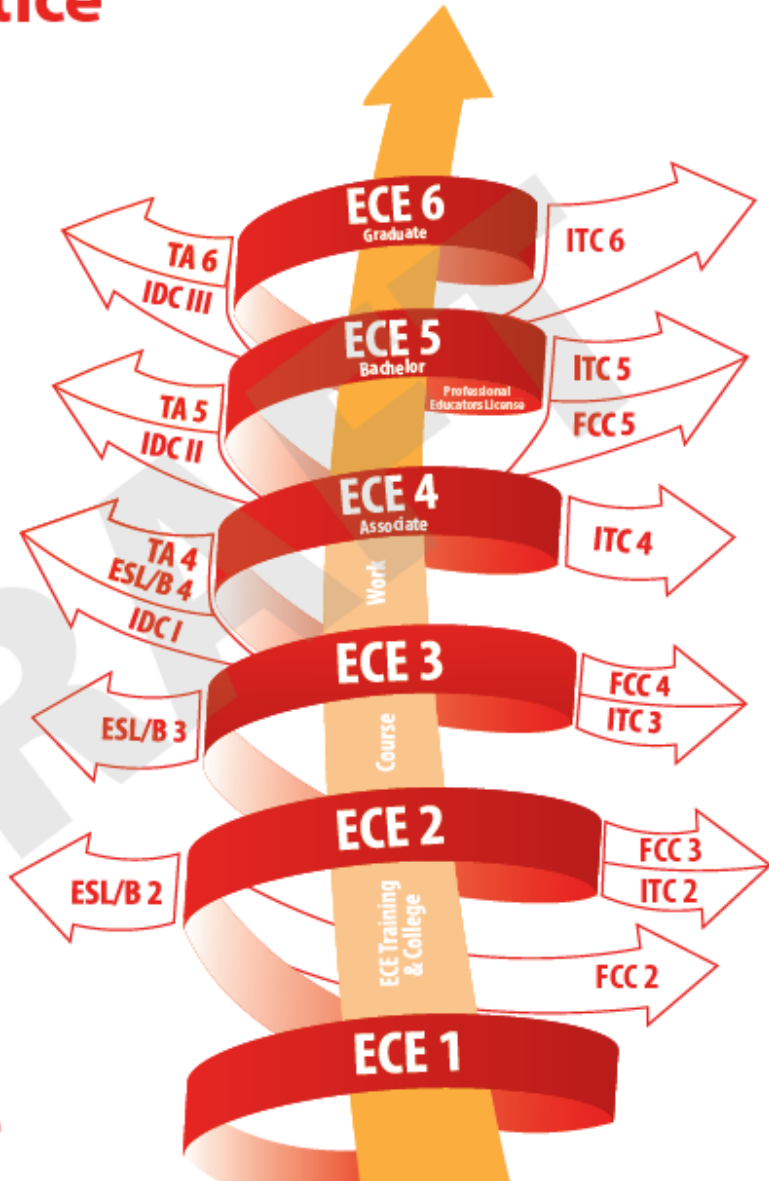

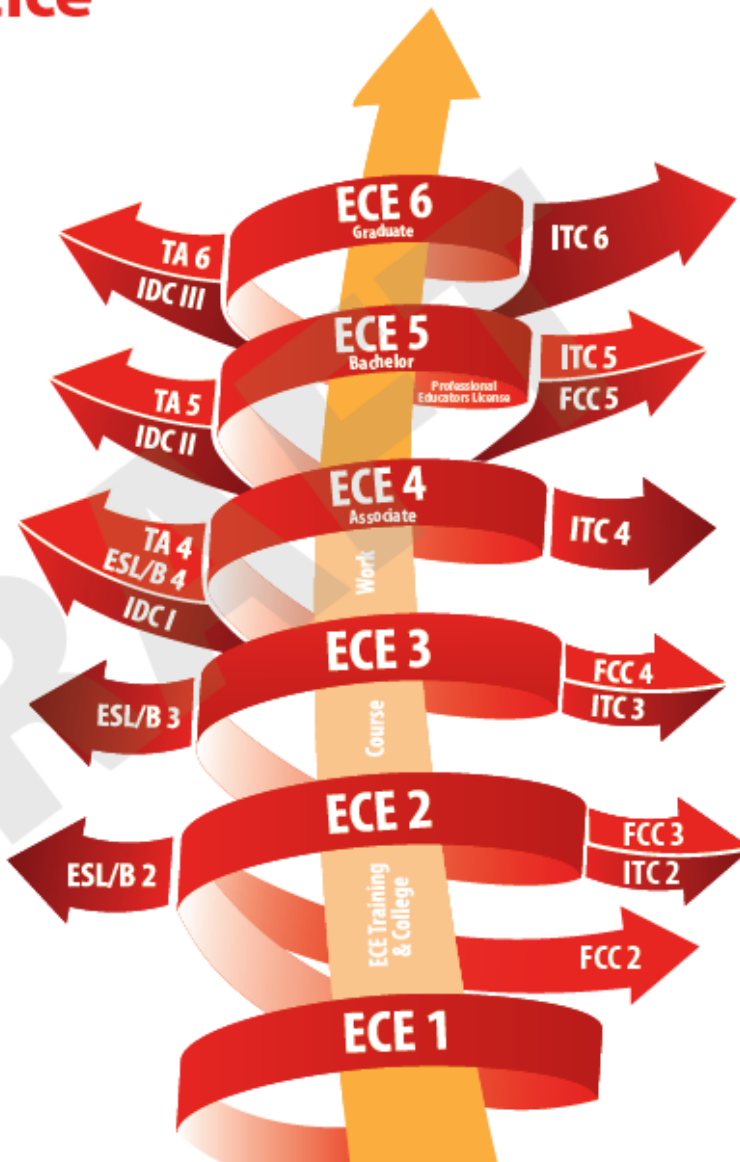

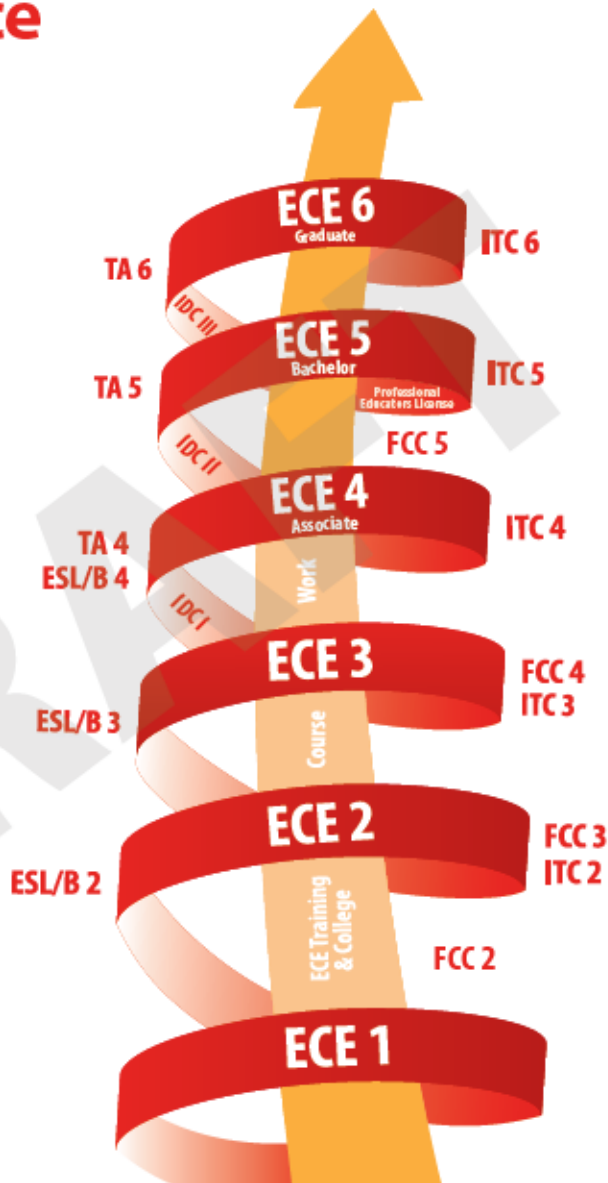
