

SMART START WORKFORCE GRANTS

Smart Start Workforce Grants offer child care programs stable, ongoing funds that they need to cover costs and invest in quality staff without burdening families by raising tuition or Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) copays. Eligible programs receive consistent funding in advance, and funds will cover the cost of higher wages and operating a classroom. Programs receiving these grants will be required to pay assistants a wage floor. These competitive wages will help to attract more staff and meet parents' needs at a rate that they can afford.
