The Gateways Scholarship Program is available to assist Apprentices from the Illinois Early Childhood Apprenticeship Pilot!

The Gateways Scholarship Program is an individual-based scholarship opportunity for professionals working in early care and education. The program provides financial assistance for early childhood education and child development (*ECE/CD*) coursework and degrees offered through participating colleges and universities, dependent on available funding. Scholarships will be awarded to a maximum of 25 Apprentices on a first come, first served basis. The Gateways Scholarship Program is administered by the Illinois Network of Child Care Resource and Referral Agencies (*INCCRRA*) and funded by the Illinois Department of Human Services (*IDHS*).

If you are an Apprentice working at a participating Illinois Early Childhood Apprenticeship Pilot site, you may be eligible to receive:

- 100% tuition assistance for coursework in approved certificate, endorsement, or degree programs
- Up to \$250 per class for books*
- Debt relief of up to \$1,500 yearly to assist with an outstanding balance at an accredited Illinois college or university**
